



## Site of former Circuit City in Salisbury sold

SALISBURY — An investment partnership of area and distance business people has bought the former Circuit City retail box store for close to \$2.6 million.

Henry Hanna of Sperry Van Ness-Miller Commercial Real Estate announced the sale late Friday, saying that “we have a couple of companies talking about leasing space there.” For two months through October, though, Spirit Halloween costume and occasions decoration national retailer will occupy the 25,000 square-foot space on North Salisbury Boulevard, said Hanna, who with Wesley Cox of Sperry Van Ness represented the seller, Mayfair MDCC, a business trust in Chicago.

Blair Rinnier, of Rinnier Development of Salisbury, represented the buyer of the property that wished to remain anonymous, Hanna said. Two companies interested in long-term leases are retailers from outside the region. Read continuing coverage in the business section of The Daily Times on Saturday.
